

A refreshing project

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An Antigonish idea is in the running to win a Pepsi Refresh Project grant.

The idea to bring together 200 inspiring youth in Atlantic Canada was submitted by the St. F.X. Enterprise Development Centre. It's now in the running for \$10,000.

In less than a year, the Pepsi Refresh Project grant program has awarded more than \$800,000 to fund more than 40 great ideas promoting positive social change across Canada. Now entering its fifth cycle, online voting for the next round of ideas is open and another \$200,000 is up for grabs. Past grant recipients include a 12-year-old boy who is building a playground for kids in a remote community, a student who is taking a stand by creating an anti-bullying documentary and a high school that offered the rare treat of a video dance party for

its special needs students. Melissa MacMaster, youth entrepreneurship co-ordinator for XEDC, said she heard about the Pepsi Refresh Project on television, adding she thought it would be a great fit for the Atlantic Canada Youth Entrepreneurship Summit.

"I just saw a commercial," she said. "This was at the beginnings stages of the development for the youth summit when we were looking for financial support to make it happen."

MacMaster said she filled out an application and submitted it.

The Atlantic Canada Youth Entrepreneurship Summit will be held at St. F.X. from May 13 to 15. This inaugural youth summit will bring together 200 inspiring youth entrepreneurs, innovators, change makers and emerging leaders from age 15 to 29 from across the Atlantic Provinces.

"[The summit will provide an opportunity] to really talk

about issues around youth out migration in our coastal and rural communities as well as how to make entrepreneurship more accessible to youth," MacMaster said.

The summit will provide youth a chance to exchange ideas and strategies on how to create a culture of innovative entrepreneurship and will provide youth a chance to build provincial networks of support and develop partnerships.

MacMaster said participants will have the option to follow four different learning streams: linking entrepreneurship to long-term economic growth; strengthening entrepreneurship skills; leadership development; and social and innovative entrepreneurship.

There has been a lot of youth interest so far from each of the four provinces, she said, adding there will be 90 youth accepted from Nova Scotia, 50 from P.E.I. and 20 from Newfoundland.

"We have a lot of bursary applications available for any youth that want to attend," MacMaster said. "They can just go to our website."

MacMaster said she thought the Atlantic Canada Youth Entrepreneurship Summit was a good fit for the Pepsi Refresh Project grant program because one of the categories is for education.

"That's where I saw the fit with the summit and the Pepsi Challenge and I just thought it would be a great way to get some extra money to support this great opportunity and initiative. Also to spread awareness about the summit itself."

Those interested have until April 30 to vote for the Atlantic Canada Youth Entrepreneurship Summit for the Pepsi Refresh Challenge. The top 10 ideas that receive the most votes win. A person can vote once each day.
